

## Alton Park Sports Premium Funding 2016-2017

### Autumn Term 2016

The school continues to benefit from the Sports Premium funding. Our latest allocation in November was £10,250 . We have used the funding for the following :

- £1,739 has been committed to Clacton Cannons basketball club for curriculum time coaching within years 5 and 6. This will extend to other year groups throughout the year. ( This has enabled the up levelling of skills for classroom teachers and enabled pupils to have access to an alternative team sport, run by qualified coaches. It has also allowed more pupils to take part in an Inter-schools league)
- £270 has been spent on judo coaching through Clacton Judo club. Years 5 and 6 have judo sessions in curriculum time.
- £ 154.95 has been spent on replacing and improving sports equipment. New rugby equipment and tags were purchased so that children could take part in an Inter school tag rugby tournament.

- We shared the cost of the purchase of judo mats with Holland Park, our Academy partners. £404.17. The equipment will be shared throughout the year and Clacton Judo club will be engaged to work with the children and set up clubs and curriculum time sessions. ( this will help to engage more youngsters in a physical activity, especially those not involved in team sports. Taster sessions last year proved very popular. It may also have a beneficial effect on general behaviour within the schools)
- £50 was spent with Birch Hall Outdoor Adventures on a year 6 'Mud Run'. This enabled several pupils to compete against other schools on an outdoor, adventure assault course !
- £100 has been used on transport costs to get teams to cross country and tag rugby tournaments and away football fixtures.
- £380 has been spent on a Box2bfit kitbag which is a fun fitness programme sustainable in schools and ensures full participation within small, indoor spaces.
