

Sports Premium Funding for Alton Park Primary School

Summer Term 2017

- £600 was spent on delivering mini squash sessions in curriculum time. (this has improved hand/eye co-ordination for pupils in year 6 and provided exit routes to local clubs)
- £1049 was spent on equipment purchases . This included footballs, rugby balls, volley balls, dodgeballs, netballs, rounders bats, cones and bibs.
- £475 was spent with Clacton Cannons Basketball Club on delivery in curriculum time for KS2 and provision of an after school club. (this has up levelled the skills of the teachers and quality of pupil performance)
- £760 was spent on a level 1 sailing course for year 6 at Alton Water in Suffolk. Additional transport costs of £310 transport were incurred) (This improved the water confidence of all pupils involved and provided exit routes to local sailing clubs.)
- £295 was the cost of coach hire for the District Athletics at the Garrison in Colchester. (This enabled a large team to compete against 9 other schools and a very creditable runners-up position achieved)
- £350 was used towards the training of a member of staff for a level 2 swimming qualification. (This enables all pupils to benefit from high quality teaching in curriculum time)
