Space Dome—4th October

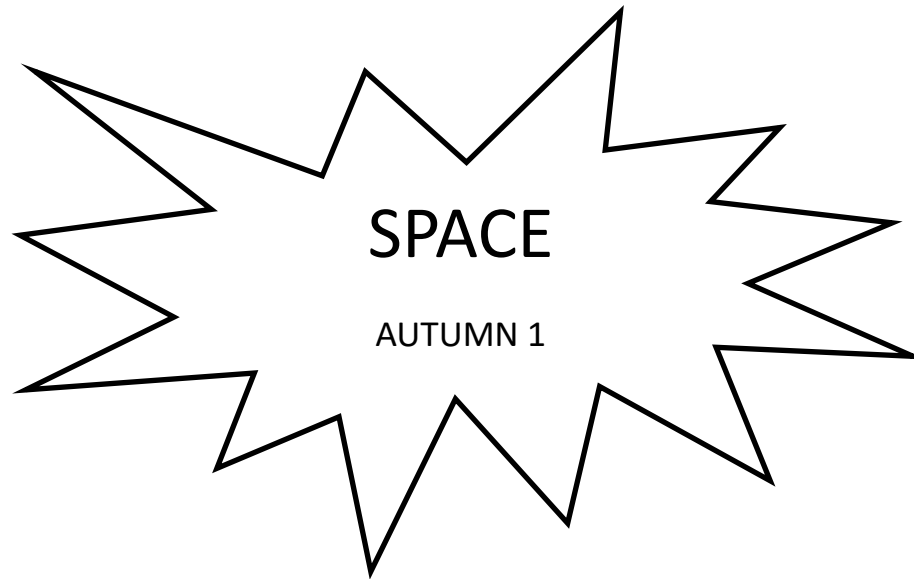
**Art—sketching**
